## Solid Foundation Horsemanship Clinic Saturday, October 12, 2019

### 9:00am-Noon: LEADership & Groundwork (with Trail Obstacles)

The horse you lead is the horse you ride. Learn how your body language is interpreted by your horse. Apply and practice preparing and asking your horse to move his feet. Groundwork is simply building respect and effectively moving the horse's body and feet how you choose when you choose. When the groundwork is solid, it translates to riding. When it isn't, that translates too. Learn more about feel, timing, release, body language and using your energy to influence your horse. Be able to ask your horse to send, disengage the hindquarters, yield the forehand, back correctly and side-pass. All skills directly link to riding. \$100

### 1:00pm-4:00pm: Groundwork in the Saddle (with Trail Obstacles)

Build on groundwork concepts and apply them to riding. It's all connected. Advanced maneuvers are simply foundation skills linked together seamlessly. You and your horse will learn feel, timing, release, disengaging the hindquarters, going forward freely, moving the shoulders (pivoting on the hindquarters), sidepassing and backing. You will learn how to clearly break down and give the right cues at the right time. \$100

### 9:00am-Noon: Training with Trail Obstacles

Builds on Groundwork in the Saddle Skills - Add finesse and precision to Trail Obstacles. Includes Side Passing (beginner or advanced), Gates, Mazes, and more advanced obstacles. Horse and rider should be able to direct the feet, pivot on front or rear, sidepass and back or take Saturday clinic. \$100
